Save money on your parking

The cheapest option for regular parking is to purchase one of our monthly permits; our permits are competitively priced and allows unlimited use of our car parking facilities on a monthly basis. To purchase a permit for our surface car parks or on-street parking you will need to use RingGo; please visit www.myringgo.co.uk/nottingham.

On-street pay and display bays and surface car parks

All our pay and display machines take **contactless** or chip and pin payment, however we have 17 machines that take coins. There are no maximum stay restrictions for the majority of our pay and display bays and surface car parks however; you must refer to local signage for further information.

Please follow this link to the website if you wish to pay by coin parking.nottinghamcity.gov.uk for the location of the machine. Please ensure you have the correct coins if paying by cash as no change is given. Failure to display a valid ticket may result in a penalty charge notice being issued.



Multi-storey car parks

We have three multi-storey car parks in Nottingham City Centre, Broad Marsh car park, Lace Market car park and Trinity Square car park. These are safe, secure and easy to use.

There are various ways to pay for your parking such as using your debit/credit card for **contactless** or chip and pin payments at the entrance and **exit barriers** (with the same card) or take a ticket on entry and pay at the pay stations.



All our multi-storey car parks and surface car parks, have been awarded The Park Mark™ award and have achieved their challenging standards. The distinctive Park Mark signage helps drivers find car parks where they can confidently leave their vehicle, knowing the environment is safer, locations of these car parks are over the page. We have also been granted the Disabled Parking Accreditation® at the Broad Marsh, Lace Market and Trinity Square multi-storey car parks this means you know and trust that the car park has been assessed and that it is accessible to disabled motorists.



Blue badge parking

Blue badge holders are able to park free of charge for an unlimited period in our on-street pay and display bays. Please note: specific 'disabled-only' parking bays may have time restrictions so always check on-street signage and notices; please ensure your badge is clearly displayed when parking. Blue badge holders are able to park for up to 3 hours free of charge in our surface car parks, please ensure your badge and clock is clearly displayed. Blue badge parking is also available in our Multi-Storey Car Parks, however standard parking charges apply, please ensure you display your blue badge when parking in these spaces.



Motorcycle parking

We have a bespoke, highly secure, dedicated motorcycle facility at Lace Market Multi-Storey car park. To access the secure cage, you need to download the **RHParking app**. We also offer motorcycle parking in specialist bay at the Broad Marsh and Trinity Square Multi-Storey car parks.



Safety and Security

All our car parks have been awarded the ParkMark Safer Parking Award (see above), we monitor our onsite CCTV 24/7 across all our car parks. We have on site security patrols 24/7 at our multi-storey car parks and do regular patrols across the surface car parks.
