Parking Permits

The cheapest option for regular parking is to purchase one of our monthly permits, which are competitively priced and allow unlimited use of our car parking facilities on a monthly basis. On-Street Pay and Display Bays and Surface Car Parks

We have 70 on-street and display machines across the city centre, all of which take contactless payment and 16 take cash. There are no maximum stay restrictions for most pay and display bays and surface car parks, however, you must refer to local signage for further information.

Please follow this link to the website if you wish to pay by cash parking.nottinghamcity.gov.uk for the location of the machine. Please ensure you have the correct coins if paying by cash as no change is given. Failure to display a valid ticket may result in a penalty charge notice being issued.



Multi-Storey Car Parks

We have three multi-storey car parks in Nottingham City Centre: Broad Marsh Car Park, Lace Market Car Park and Trinity Square Car Park. These are safe, secure and easy to use.

You can pay for your parking in Broad Marsh and Lace Market Car Park by 'tapping in and out' with your debit/credit card for contactless or chip and pin payments at the entrance and exit barriers (using the same card). In all multi-storey car parks you can pay by taking a ticket on entry and paying at the pay stations with card or cash, or at the barrier on exit.

Safety and Security

All of our car parks have been awarded The Park Mark™ award for their high levels of maintenance and low levels of crime, and Broad Marsh Car Park has been awarded Park Mark Plus status. We monitor our onsite CCTV across all car parks and have on site security patrols at our multi-storey car parks 24/7.



Our multi-storey car parks have also been granted the Disabled Parking Accreditation®. This means that the car parks have been identified as accessible to disabled motorists.



Blue Badge Holder Parking

You can park for free in any on-street pay and display bay as long as a valid Blue Badge is clearly displayed. Please note: specific 'disabled-only' parking bays may have time restrictions so always check on-street signage and notices.

Blue badge parking is available in our multi-storey car parks in the dedicated bays. Standard parking charges apply, please ensure you display your blue badge when parking in these spaces.



Motorcycle Parking

On street parking is free within dedicated motorcycle pay and display bays. Unless signage indicates otherwise, there are no maximum stay restrictions. Motorcycles must be parked in the secure cage at Lace Market Car Park and in the designated motorcycle areas at Trinity Square and Broad Marsh Car Park. No charge applies.



Broad Marsh Car Park

A total of 81 fast EV charge points are available across levels 2-5 of Broad Marsh Car Park, along with a vehicle management system of electronic signs and lights showing available parking spaces. 720 solar panels on the roof also provide renewable electricity to power the car park and bus station, helping you to travel sustainably.
